GENERAL RULES:

1. All entries have to be pre-registered by August 31st. Only 50 show people allowed. Entries will be taken on first come first serve basis.
2. The 4-H Beef Invitational is open to all current 4-H members 9 years to 21 years old that are 2017 4-H paid members in Ontario.
 - 2.1. The age of the exhibitor is taken as of January 1, 2017.
 - 2.2. All entries in the 4-H Beef Invitational must be the member's own 4-H project for 2017.
 - 2.3. Animals may be either purebred or crossbred.
3. Each exhibitor is allowed one (1) entry in either Market Calf, Heifer Calf, Heifer Junior Yearling, Heifer Senior Yearling classes.
 - 3.1. No animal may be shown in more than one conformation or showmanship class.
4. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry of any animal that shows signs of ill health at time of arrival or show.
5. All exhibitors must show in 4-H colours (white shirt, black pants), no hat or sunglasses.
 - 5.1. Exhibitors failing to comply with this regulation will be refused entry into the ring with their animal.
 - 5.2. Advertising of exhibitor's name or farm on clothing is not permitted in the show ring.
6. All animals entered in the IPM Beef Invitational must be presented in show condition
 - 6.1. Animal is clean and trimmed prior to attending the show.
 - 6.2. Animal must be brought to event in show condition – no washing, generators, chutes etc are permitted on grounds.
7. Bedding for 4-H project
 - 7.1. No bedding will be supplied on day of show
 - 7.2. If you wish to bring bedding for 4-H project, straw is the only bedding permitted
8. Male market calves must be castrated.
9. The committee reserves the right to alter rules as required on show day.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TIME:

1. All cattle competing at the IPM 4-H Beef Invitational must be on the grounds by 8:00 am and must be kept on the grounds until after 5:00 pm.
2. Confirmation of registration at 9:00am
3. Show starts at 10:00am
