GENERAL RULES:

- 1. All entries have to be pre-registered by August 31st. Only 100 show people allowed. Entries will be taken on first come first serve basis.
- 2. The 4-H Sheep Invitational is open to all current 4-H members 9 years to 21 years old that are 2017 4-H paid members in Ontario (and Future Farmers 4 8 years of age).
 - 2.1. The age of the exhibitor is taken as of January 1, 2017.
 - 2.2. All entries in the 4-H Sheep Invitational must be the member's own 4-H project for 2017.
 - 2.3. Animals may be either purebred or crossbred.
- 3. Each exhibitor is allowed one (1) entry in either Breeding Ewe or Market Lamb class.
 - 3.1. No animal may be shown in more than one conformation or showmanship class.
 - 3.2. Market lambs will be weighed morning of show to determine if in heavy or light class.
- 4. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry of any lamb that shows signs of ill health at time of arrival or show.
- 5. All exhibitors must show in 4-H colours (white shirt, black pants), no hat or sunglasses.
 - 5.1. Exhibitors failing to comply with this regulation will be refused entry into the ring with their sheep.
 - 5.2. Advertising of exhibitor's name or farm on clothing is not permitted in the show ring.
- 6. All sheep entered in the IPM 4-H Sheep Invitational must be presented in show condition
 - 6.1. Animal is clean, tail docked, trimmed or sheared prior as appropriate to the breed.
 - 6.2. Sheep must be brought to event in show condition no washing, shearing etc allowed on grounds of IPM *TAIL LENGTH REQUIREMENTS* as per Canadian Sheep Breeders Association
 - 2016- No lambs will be culled for tail length, but producers with a divot or indentation will receive a warning and education materials on proper protocols. 2017- Lambs with a divot or indentation will be culled from the show. 2018- Lambs must have a caudal fold that can be seen or felt, or will be culled from the show.
- 7. Male market lambs must be castrated.
- 8. Bedding for 4-H project
 - 8.1. No bedding will be supplied on day of show
 - 8.2. If you wish to bring bedding for 4-H project, straw is the only bedding permitted
- 9. The committee reserves the right to alter rules as required on show day.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TIME:

- 1. All sheep competing at the IPM 4-H Sheep Invitational must be on the grounds by 8:00 am and must be kept on the grounds until after 5:00 pm.
- 2. Weighing of market lambs starts at 8:30am
- 3. Confirmation of registration at 9:00am
- 4. Show starts at 10:00 am
