



IPM 2022 - RV Park Rules

Check-in and Check-out – Hours of Operation

- **Check-in:** Saturday, Sept. 17th from 11:00 am to 6:00 pm
- **Check-in:** Sunday, Sept. 18th to Saturday, Sept. 24th from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm
- **Daily Check-outs:** before 11 am
- **Final Check-out:** Sunday, Sept. 25th by 2:00 pm
- **The RV Park Registration Office will be open daily from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm**

Golf Cart / ATV / UTV/ Scooter Use

To help ensure the health and safety of the operators and guests the Ontario Highway Traffic Act rules governing the operation of these vehicles will apply while on the grounds. OPP will be monitoring use and adherence to these regulations.

- No more than one person per vehicle unless otherwise specified that the vehicle can legally accommodate more than one passenger.
- Maximum speed limit is 10 kms/hr.
- The approved times of Camper operations of these vehicles on the grounds is from 7:00 am to 11:00 pm.
- Campers operating these vehicles must have proof, on hand, of valid operators licence and insurance documentation while operating on the IPM grounds.
- The above motorized vehicles are not permitted on the Tented City grounds. A parking area will be designated near Tented City. (IPM volunteers and staff may operate the above motorized vehicles within the RV Park and Tented City as and when required – on the Service Roads).
- The campers that require mobility assistance to get around the RV Park and Tented City grounds will be permitted to operate their personal electric scooters, electric wheelchairs, etc.

RV Park Generator Operation

- For the campers in the non-serviced areas, only **“inverted generators”** are permitted.
- To be respectful to all campers, the hours that generators may be in operation are between 9:00 am to 9:00 pm.
- During the operation of the generator, there must always be a responsible person on the site to monitor.
- Campers must have proper safety equipment on hand (fire extinguisher) while operating the generator.
- Refueling safety equipment, fire extinguisher, protective eyewear, etc., must be on hand during refueling. Generators must be turned OFF and allowed to cool prior to and while refueling.

Fires, Smoking, Consumption

- No open fires (including propane fuelled fire pits) are permitted anywhere in the RV Park.
- Smoking permitted only on camper's site. Butts/ash must be disposed of in a responsible manner. Remember, we are camping in a hay field!
- Responsible open-air consumption of personal alcoholic beverages is only allowed within the confines of each camping site and outside of quiet time.

Quiet Time

- Quiet time is from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am

Pets

- Pets must be on a leash at all times and owners must pick up after their pets and dispose of the pet waste in a responsible manner.
- Pets are not permitted in Tented City or the RV Park Entertainment tent. Only service animals are permitted in these areas.
- Any animal bite/scratch/exposure **MUST** be reported to the RV Park Registration Office immediately and the Animal Exposure Report form completed (as required by the Leeds, Grenville and Lanark Health Unit).

Garbage and Recyclables

- Camper garbage/recycling collection from the camper sites will commence every morning at 7:30 am beginning Monday, September 19th. In an attempt to deter unwanted nocturnal visitors, please refrain from putting out garbage the night before.
- **“4H Club Bottle Drive”** “Each camper will be given one clear plastic recycling bag in your camper welcome kit. Please use this bag to store all refundable alcohol (beer can, beer bottles, wine and liquor bottles) during the course of your stay. We would ask that you drop them at the south exit gate on your departure for collection by local 4H members. The 4H Club members appreciate your support.

Sanitation

- Dump station will be provided at check out at no cost to camper.
- Site pick up will be available through our service provider, coordinated by the camper, at the cost of the camper. Contact numbers will be provided.
- Grey/black water dumping at camp site is strictly forbidden and will be monitored by site and security staff. Violators may be subject to MOE and Health Unit enforcement.

Guest/Visitors Policy

- All RV Park visitors must be a guest of a registered camper and will be required to sign in at the Dickinson Trail North entrance gate. Visitors wishing to attend the RV Park entertainment tent must purchase a pass for \$10.00 during the day at the RV Park registration office or at the entrance to the entertainment tent.
- Visitor vehicles must be parked on visited site only and not on RV Park Lanes.

Notes

- No seating will be provided at the RV Park entertainment tent. Please bring your own chair
- RV Park gate(s) access will be restricted between 11:00 pm and 9:00 am.

Should any person(s) not adhere to these rules and regulations they may be subject to Provincial fines and may be ejected from the IPM grounds.
