



# Antique and Historical Displays

## SAFETY RULES, REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

1. All operators of motor vehicles, including tractors, must have a valid driver's license and/or be at least 18 years of age.
2. Working equipment must be attended at all times. Display/show areas must have a defined, tidy perimeter.
3. Report all unsafe practices or conditions to an IPM 2025 Committee member. When necessary, further safety regulations may be issued during IPM.
4. No exhibits are to be moved without permission or escort of an IPM 2025 Committee member.
5. Working displays will be provided with "show time" notice boards.
6. Exhibit description signage will be provided.
7. Site protection will be provided from Thursday, September 11 at noon to Sunday, September 21 at noon.
8. Neither Ontario Plowmen's Association, nor the 2025 International Plowing Match and Rural Expo, can be held responsible for theft, damage or accidents.
9. The OPA and the IPM 2025 Committee reserves the right to take action against any exhibitor not following rules.
10. No merchandising of any kind is allowed on the grounds of the Antiques and Historical Display without the express written consent of the Ontario Plowmen's Association.
11. All applications are subject to a selection routine. Approval notice will be issued by Ontario Plowmen's Association and/or 2025 International Plowing Match and Expo Local Committee.
12. Preference will be given to unique antiques with a strong connection to Niagara Region, Ontario.
13. Please note: The deadline for registration will be Monday, September 1, 2025.
14. Exhibits must arrive by 4 pm on Monday, September 15 and remain on-site for the duration of the Match. Absolutely no exit before 5 pm on Saturday, September 20 due to insurance liability issues.
  - Exhibitors are responsible for making arrangements for transporting their exhibits.
  - To complete registration, all exhibitors must provide a valid insurance certificate that states they carry a minimum of \$2 million comprehensive liability insurance and lists the Ontario Plowmen's Association and the 2025 International Plowing Match & Rural Expo Local Committee Inc. as an additional insured.
  - Steam boilers must be licensed and certified.
  - No antiques exhibitor vehicles are allowed on the show grounds during public hours: 8:30 am - 5 pm.
  - Only service animals are allowed on the IPM grounds.
  - All exhibitors with working displays must have their fire extinguisher and first aid kit.
15. Antiques exhibitors will be provided with passes on the following basis:
  - Static display/collection (non-working): 1 pass only in total per exhibitor (total one pass)
  - Small working exhibits: 1 pass only per day per exhibitor
  - Large working exhibits: 1 pass per day per person
